7. **Add the Whiskers:** Using a thin liner brush and black polish, draw three fine lines on each side of the face, starting from just beside the cheeks and curving outwards. Keep them light and thin.
8. **Seal the Design:** Once you are satisfied and the polish is completely dry, apply a generous layer of top coat. This will smooth everything out, add shine, and

protect your artwork. For a dimensional look, you can add a bow charm on top of the painted bow before the top coat dries.
