George’s innocence and gentle disposition make him a favourite among young viewers who see a bit of themselves in his toddler ways.

Mummy Pig

Mummy Pig is a kind, patient, and resourceful mother who works from home as a computer programmer. She wears a bright orange dress and is known for her calm demeanour, even when dealing with Peppa’s mischief or Daddy Pig’s mishaps. Mummy Pig is a firm believer in the importance of family time, and she often joins the children in their games, whether it’s jumping in puddles, playing board games, or baking cakes. She also enjoys reading map books, a running joke throughout the series. Mummy Pig’s gentle authority and loving nature provide a stable foundation for the Pig household.

Daddy Pig
